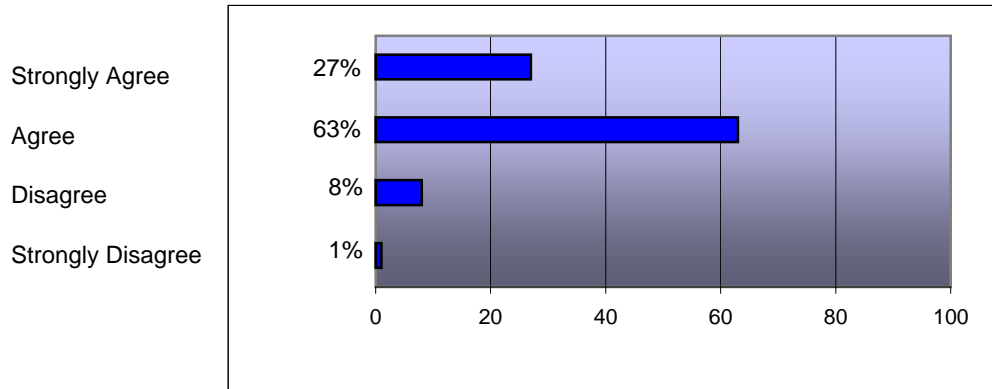

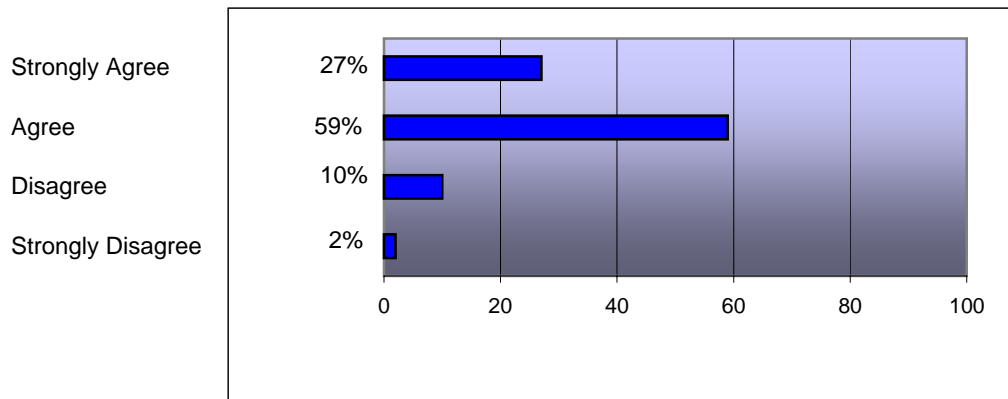

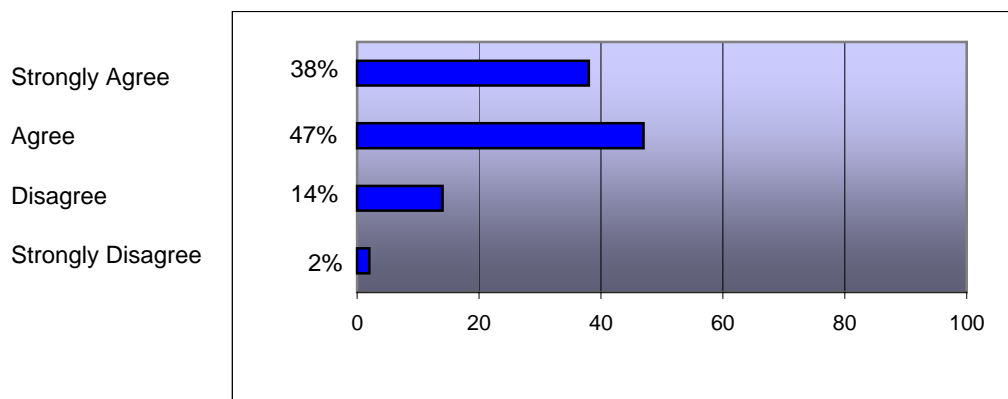

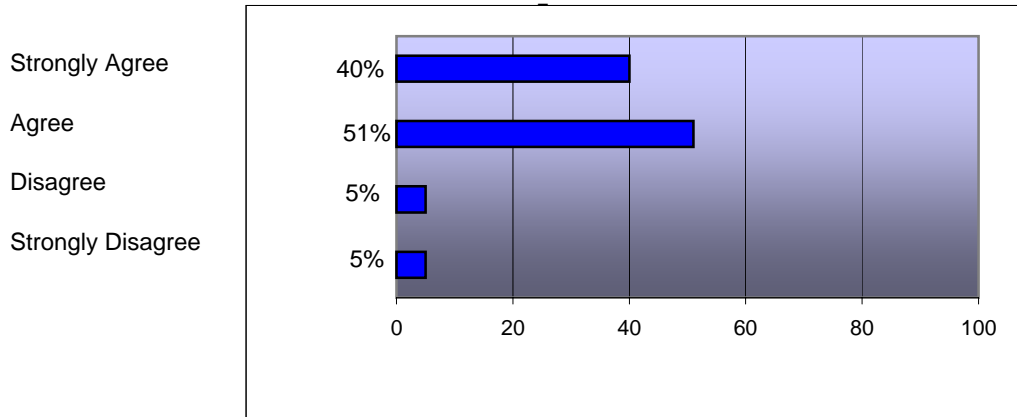

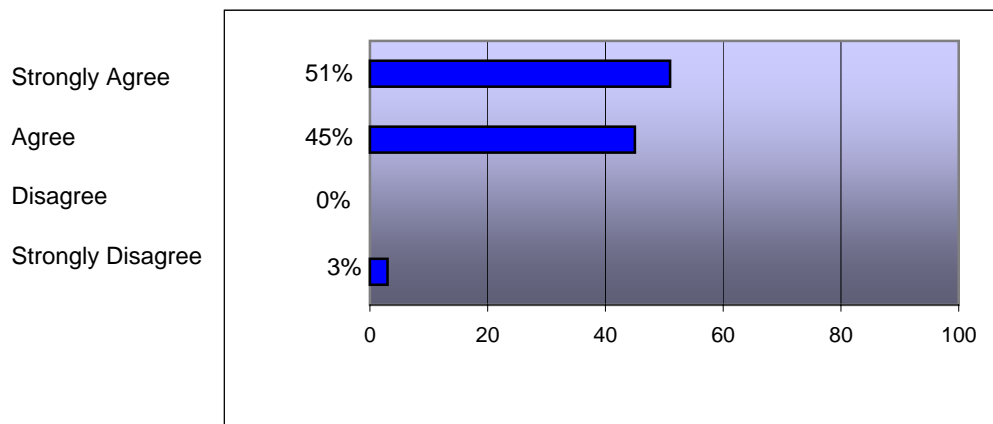

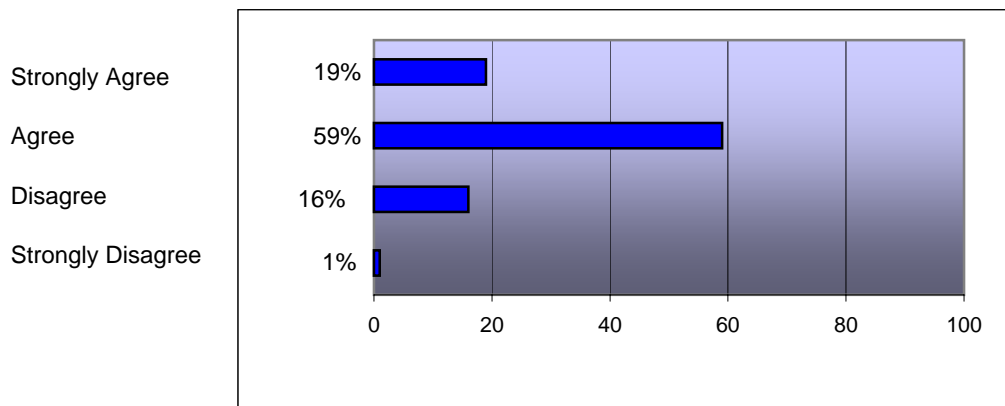

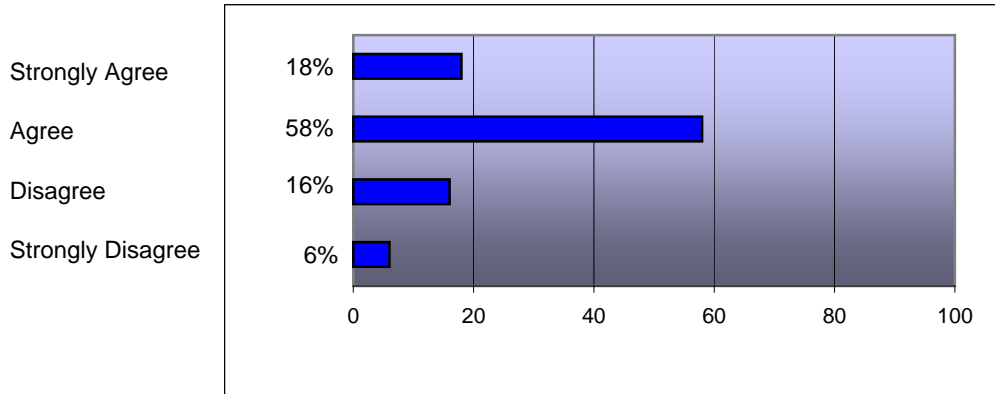

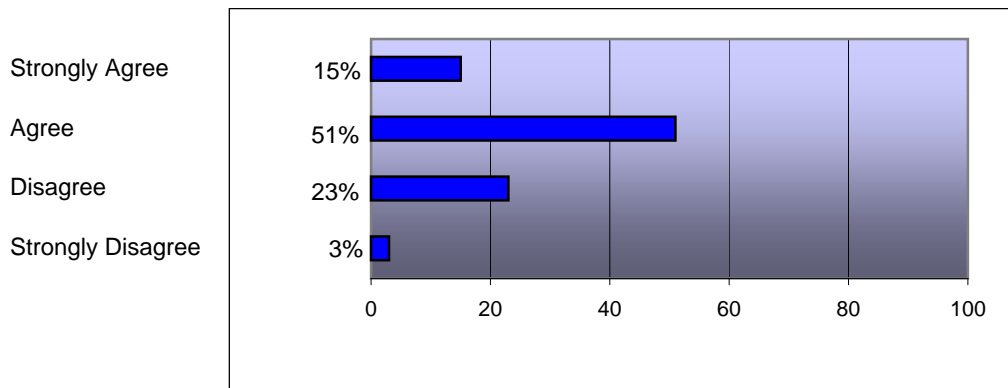

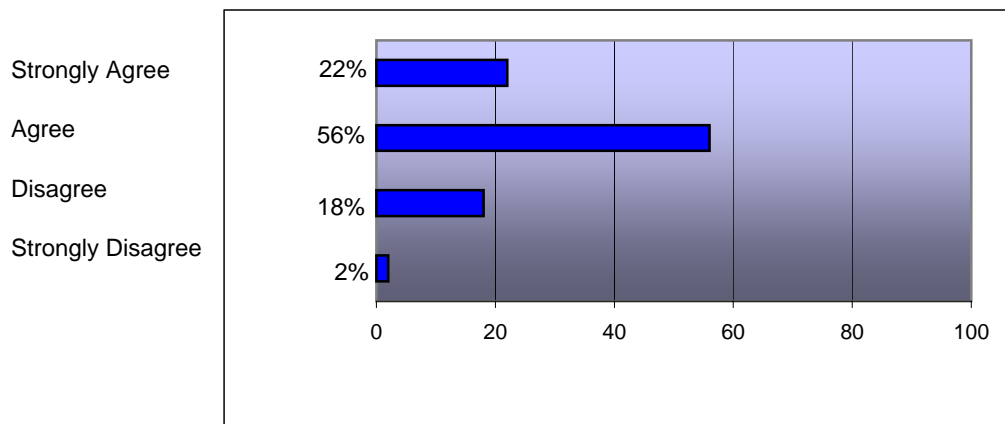

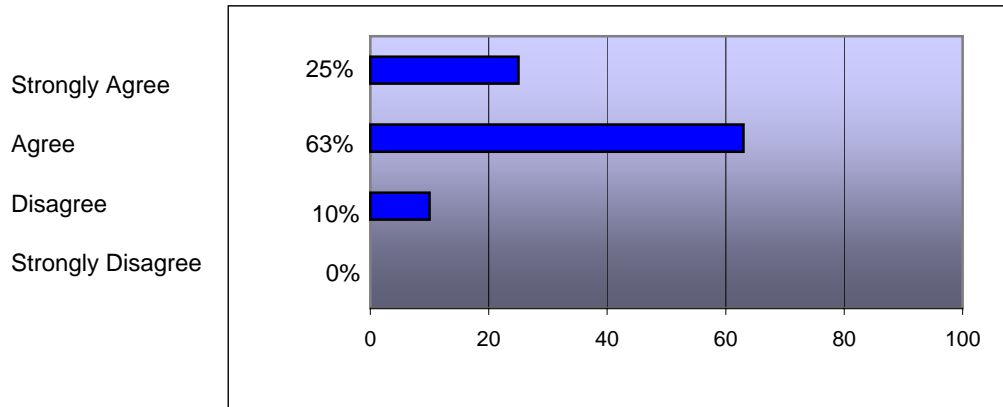

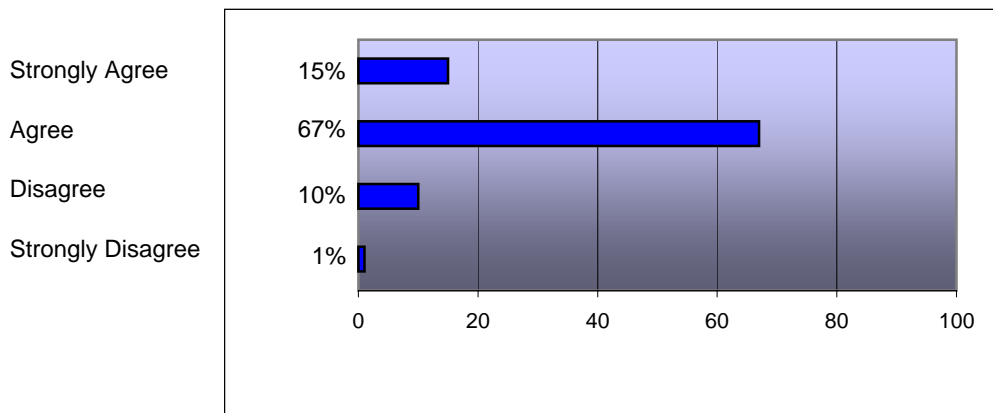

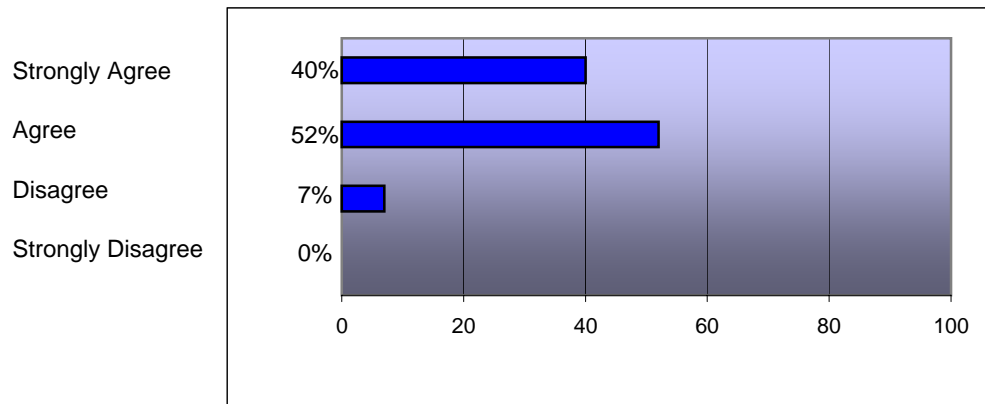

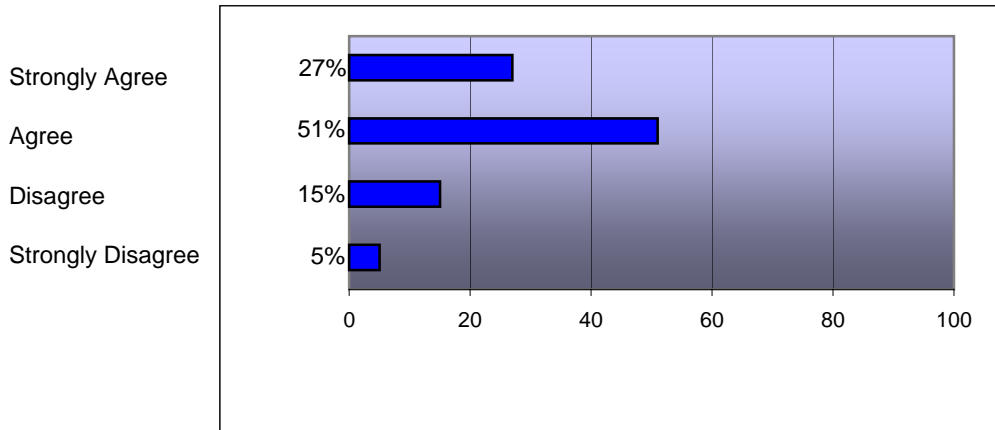

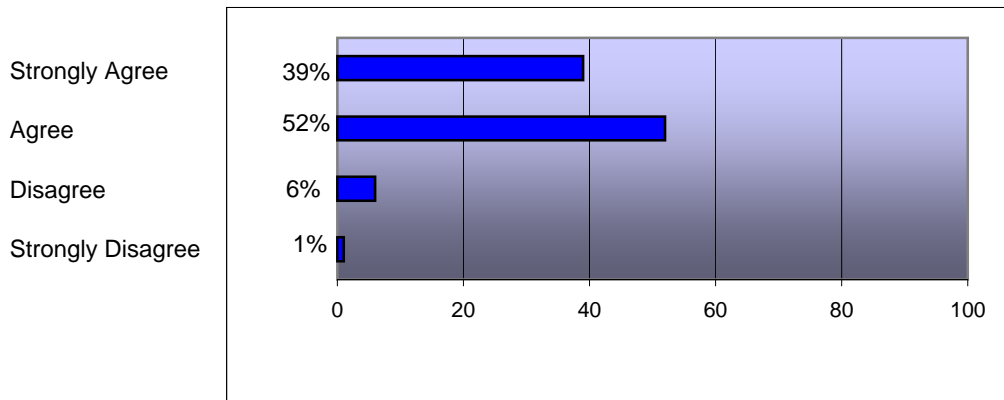

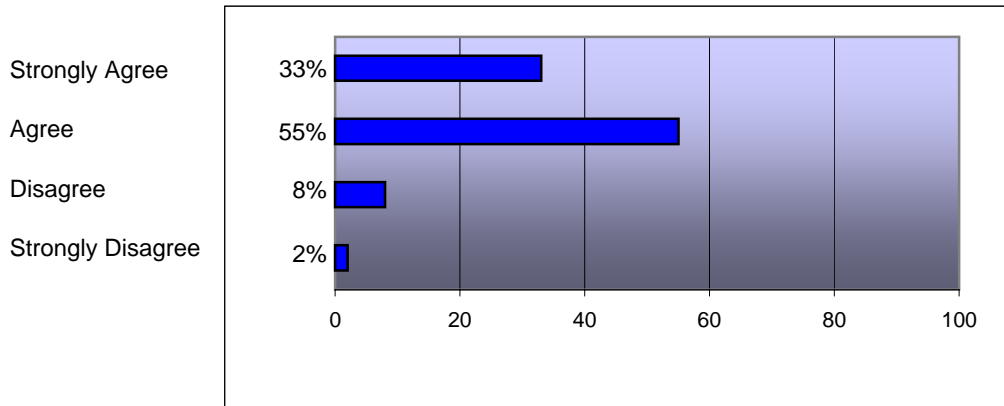

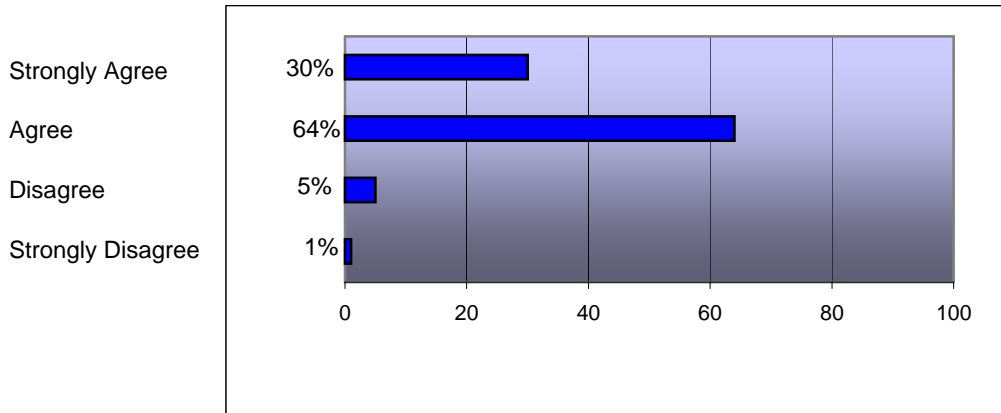

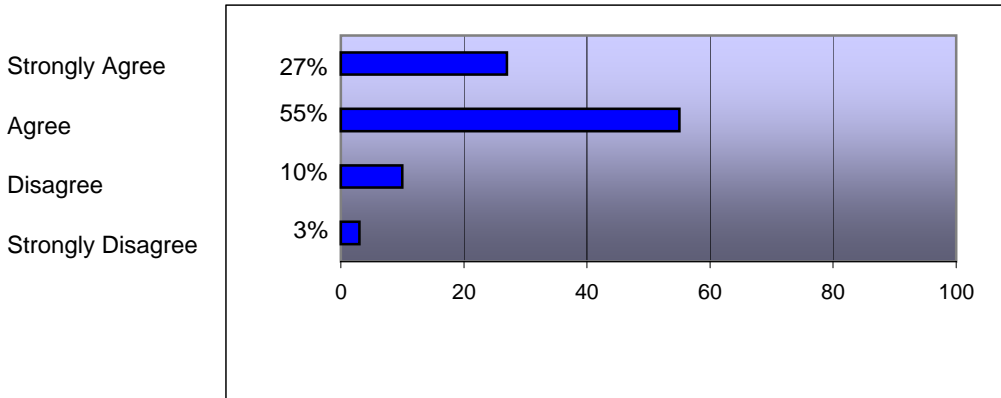

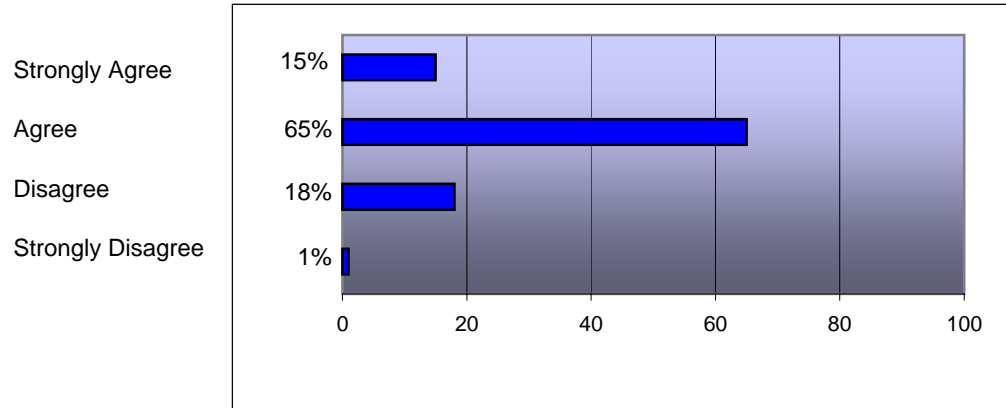

20. Students learn to apply scientific reasoning to solve problems in science

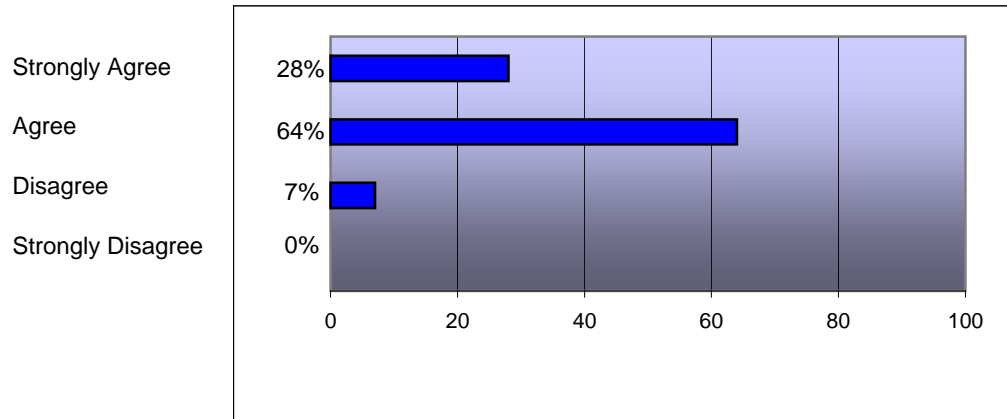


21. Our teachers give children the right amount of homework for their grade level
